Here are this year’s activities and ways to get involved:

9:00 a.m. – 10 a.m.

Youth/Activity Center: assembling 100 “weekend bags” for hungry kids (Communities in Schools)

Fellowship Hall: Time Capsule! Write notes to the future, assemble what we have gathered, and seal it up.

11:00 a.m. – approximately 1:30 p.m.

Finish any earlier projects.

Two projects at New Life Center – leave immediately from worship:

1. painting the picnic shelter (the old outdoor chapel). Ladders needed, all other supplies provided.
2. activities with the girls. We will play games and help them do a service project making cards.

Supplies needed, for those who wish to donate:

For the project with the girls at New Life: markers or colored pencils, stickers (especially hearts and patriotic), and card stock (nothing will be returned).

For the Time Capsule: anything you still want included! Pictures, notes – but nothing you need access to for the next 49+ years.
